



All Star Program

The All Star Program is open to all students, and is an exceptional way to go about obtaining a music education! In addition to taking a one-hour weekly private lesson, students attend a 50-minute weekly Music Appreciation class where they will study music theory, history, and literature. The program is designed to give students a comprehensive music education.

Private Lessons offer students the means to learn technique and playing skills on a specific instrument, while allowing students the opportunity to work one-on-one with a teacher. As the central means to learning an instrument, the private lesson curriculum is customized for each student to best tailor to the students requirements.

The Music Appreciation class gives students the knowledge to become exceptional musicians and well-rounded students. Students learn the basics of Music Theory, explore the history of music during the last three-hundred years, and participate in listening labs to further cultivate their knowledge and understanding of music composition.

The following components are integrated throughout the curriculum of the All Star Program:

- Music Theory, Music History, and Music Literature
- Private Lessons on a specific instrument
- Students obtain the opportunity to learn music in a social *and* individualized environment
- Fundamental objective being to provide students a comprehensive music education
