



Family Beginning Guitar

The Family Beginning Guitar Class is designed for both adults and children, and is an excellent way for parents and children to participate in an academic setting together and bond through learning a musical instrument collectively. One or both parents may take the class, with any number of children. Children of all levels are welcome to register, however it is encouraged that ages be between 7 - 17 years old.

The class offers a wonderful way to create a positive at-home activity for children and parents to do together. Both beginners and students with a minimal amount of lesson experience are invited to register for Guitar 101. Students will learn songs, scales, and fundamental technique exercises. Class curriculum includes the following objectives:

- Formulation of proper posture and position
- Foundations of note reading in treble clef
- Basic left hand and right hand technique
- Knowledge of chords and scales
- Applying general knowledge to songs

Parent involvement helps students yield a higher result of skill; parents are able to answer questions and aid in practice outside of class.
