Music & Development

Music and the arts play an important role in the overall development of children on a variety of levels. Music Therapy is the use of music, in a client-therapist interaction, to work toward specific cognitive, physical, social, communicative and emotional goals. Students participating in the MDT Program are given the opportunity to develop specific skill-sets, through the use of music, creativity and the arts in a fun and rewarding environment.

Benefits of Music & Dev Therapy

Cognitive & Academic... Facilitates repetition and reinforcement for developing language skills / Provides mnemonic device for rote learning / Provides multi-sensory stimulation / Exercises auditory discrimination

Social & Communicative... Encourages language use / Provides non-verbal means for communication / Facilitates social interaction / Creates a sense of connection and belonging

Physical & Motor... Expands range of motion / Increases motor and hand-eye coordination / Improves circulation and strength / Enhances oral motor facility

Behavioral... Engages child in focused activities / Reduces agitation and aggression

Emotional... Validates personal identity through self-expression / Boosts self-esteem through successful experiences



Programs

Adaptive Music Lessons
Adaptive music lessons are offered for children of all ages, on instruments such as piano, voice, guitar or general music. Children receive lessons by teachers with backgrounds working with children with developmental delays in a one-on-one setting.

Music Therapy
Music therapy is offered for children of all ages, and focuses on using music and movement to facilitate development of specific skill-sets as determined by the therapist and the parent. Individual and group therapy available.

Developmental Therapy
Developmental therapy is offered for children of all ages, and is especially useful with children ages 0 - 5 years old with developmental delays. Therapy uses play and arts-related tools to facilitate development. Individual and group therapy available.
