



# Adult Beginning Violin

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The Adult Beginning Violin Class is designed for adult students whom are new to the violin, or have had previous violin experience in the distant past. Adults returning to the violin with an exceptional amount of previous knowledge are encouraged to enroll in private lessons.

Students work in small groups of 3 - 5 students per class; curriculum includes both left hand and right hand basic technique, proper posture, fundamental note-reading skills, and defined repertoire. Students work within a beginning level book, as well as non-published material as directed by the instructor.

Adult Beginning Violin curriculum includes the following objectives and topics:

- Development of proper body positioning
- Improvement of left hand finger positioning
- Right hand / bow technique training
- Fundamental note reading skills
- Basic Music Theory comprehension

Students interested in learning the violin for personal or professional growth are encouraged to join the class. Additionally, parents with young children learning the violin are also encouraged to register for the class in order to best aid their child in their individual growth. As a hobby, learning tool, or to develop a music profession — enrollment in the Adult Beginning Violin class is a great way to begin playing the violin.
