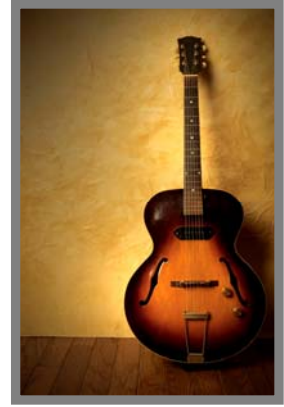


Adult Guitar



The Adult Guitar Classes are a collection of classes designed for different levels of adult guitar students, from beginning to intermediate levels of playing. Advanced guitar players looking to further develop their skills are encouraged to register for private lessons with a professional guitarist. Students learn basic and intermediate foundations of guitar playing proficiency, while learning songs and playing as a group.

The curriculum is revolved around an accelerated level of learning, thus providing adults a great opportunity to learn at an appropriate age level. Students work with both published materials (books), as well as non-published materials given directly to the class by the instructor. All instructors are professional guitarists and educators.

Adult Guitar curriculum includes the following objectives and topics:

- Development of proper positioning
- Improvement of left hand finger positioning
- Right hand / pick usage training
- Fundamental note reading skills
- Basic Music Theory comprehension

Students are encouraged to take two (2) sessions (16-weeks total) of Adult Guitar before entering into private lessons, in order to best develop basic knowledge and skill. The group setting offers students a great way to play with other musicians while learning a new instrument.
