



Beginning Voice 101

The Beginning Voice 101 Class is open to students ages 11-17 years old, and introduces students to the basics of vocal repertoire and technique. Students study in a small group class (3-5 students) and explore the wonderful art of singing. Repertoire includes elementary level art songs and a variety of vocal exercises in order to develop proper vocal technique and practice tools.

This class offers students an excellent way to begin voice training, and prepare students to begin private lesson study. Students who currently participate in school choir and theatre are encouraged to join the class, thus giving them a foundation of basic vocal ability that is directly applicable to choir and other vocal groups.

Class curriculum includes the following objectives:

- Formulation of proper posture and position
- Foundations of breathing / breathe technique
- Basic notation reading skill
- Knowledge of basic vocal exercises
- Elementary Repertoire construction

Students of beginning and intermediate level may register for Beginning Voice 101. Students are recommended to take Beginning Voice 101 for a minimum of two 8-week sessions. Following recommended classes include Madrigals, Musical Theatre Vocal Class and private voice lessons.
