

Music Appreciation



Music Appreciation classes add an academic component to the education of all musicians. Especially critical for high school students planning on taking musical discourse in college, the Music Appreciation classes explore the understanding of music on an academic level through the study of music history, integrated listening labs, and the study of music as related on a larger cultural level. As there are various classes of different levels, students of all ages and backgrounds are welcome to register for a Music Appreciation class. Additionally, student's whom do not currently play an instrument are encouraged to take a Music Appreciation class in order to develop an understanding of music as a cultural art form.

The following components are integrated throughout the curriculum of the Music Theory classes:

- Clef, Key, and Time Signatures
- Notation and Reading Comprehension
- Rhythmic Expressions through Mathematical Reasoning
- Chords and Scales
- Circle of Fifths
- Composition and Scoring
