



Piano I, II, III — ages 6 - 9 yrs old

Piano I, Piano II, and Piano II are introductory piano classes, geared for students that aim to continue the study of piano through private lessons. Classes are prepared with continuing study in-mind, and may be re-registered up to three (3) times during a semester (Piano I, II, & III).

Students learn core concepts of playing the piano through classroom sessions that include fine motor skill, tonal pitch relationship, and rhythmic development. Students use curriculum-based lesson & writing books, while learning proper left and right hand coordination/usage. Additionally, the class creates a social environment where students are encouraged to use their creativity within the learning process through occasional games and activities.

The fundamental objectives of the class are as follows:

- Students learn to identify notes on the keyboard
- Students begin using quarter & half notes within their playing curriculum
- Students develop a basic knowledge of notation including solfeggio, treble clef, bass clef, notes.
- Students create a foundation within their piano skills to make the private piano lesson experience more productive

The class uses keyboards as an introductory tool to playing the piano. A keyboard or piano at-home is required in order to allow students the opportunity to practice outside of the classroom. Parents are welcome to sit-in during the last 15 minutes of class, in order to review the lesson curriculum.

Basic Information

Length of Class: 50-minutes, weekly

At home commitment: 1 hour a week (10+ minutes practice time per day)
