

# Rock Band

---



This class is a great way for students that play guitar, bass, drums, keyboards, or vocals to participate in a group musical setting and learn their favorite rock songs. Students will work under a professional musician to develop playing skills, ability to play as a group, and learn how to write a song in a band setting. Students ages 10—18 yrs old are welcome to join. Classes grouped according to age and level.

Curriculum includes composition, melodic/harmonic development, rhythmic expressions, and comprehension of how to play popular rock songs. Students use both rote method and notation in order to learn new songs.

Students should have a minimum of 1-year of private lessons before enrolling in Making the Band. During particular times of the year, students will have the opportunity to play in front of a live audience, and learn how to record using mainstream recording devices.

Bands that are already formed or groups of friends that play instruments are encouraged to register together to form a band or further develop an already formed band!
