



Wind Chamber Ensemble

The Wind Chamber Ensemble class is a fun and enriching class for wind players to take part in! The class is open to students whom play the following instruments: flute, piccolo, clarinet, bass clarinet, oboe, saxophone and bassoon. Additionally, pianists' whom are interested in playing chamber music may also registered.

The class structure allows students the opportunity to learn the art of chamber playing, as well as develop their own performance skills. Students are grouped according to age and level, with approximately 3 - 5 students per ensemble. Repertoire varies per ensemble, and includes music from composers such as Beethoven, Mozart, and Brahms. Coached by a professional wind performer/educator, this class will help students develop a critical part of musical performance.

Fundamental objectives of the class include development of the following:

- Sight-reading music in a group setting
- Listening to and playing with other musicians
- Understanding and applying musical development and phrasing
- Exposure to new and interesting musical repertoire

Students are encouraged to take private lessons in conjunction with the Wind Chamber Ensemble class, although private lessons are not required.

Basic Information

Length of Class: 50-minutes, weekly

Tuition: \$150 per 8-week semester

At home commitment: 1 hour + a week

Pre-requisites: Private Lessons (encouraged but not required).

Materials Required: Instrument, Metronome, Music as designated by instructor
